Agritourism



What is agritourism?

agritourism [ag-ri-**too** r-iz-uh m] [SHOW IPA](#)

noun

- 1 tourism in which tourists take part in farm or village activities, as animal and crop care, cooking and cleaning, handicrafts, and entertainments.





Why agritourism is so important?

Agrotourism is income oriented and connected with agriculture and farms and that's why it helps these farms earn money for their maintenance.

Increasing awareness of city residents about living, working and other activities in villages is also an important aspect of agrotourism.





*Where in Poland are
the most agritourism farms?*

Polish agritourism farms are located in agricultural areas and sometimes in touristic areas.

Examples of such places are the Bieszczady Mountains, Mazury Lakes and Malopolska Province.





What you can do on agritourism farms?

The most popular activities on agritourism farms are: participating in daily life on the farm, taking care of farm animals, helping with the harvest and participating in activities organized by owners of agritourism farms. Often, you can also go sightseeing near agritourism farms.
